WHAT IS FINANCIAL AID? DOES IT HELP ME?

Purpose:

Financial aid serves as a crucial support system for students and families facing the costs of higher education.

The primary goal of financial aid is to make college more affordable and accessible to students from diverse financial backgrounds.

Every student's account and eligibility will vary for many reasons, but please speak with an advisor directly to ensure you know all your options.

***NOTE:** There are many kinds of financial aid and you can apply for many of these options based on your eligibility*

***EXAMPLES:** FAFSA, Scholarships, Institutional Funding, Grants, State Aid, Etc.*

- The FAFSA is an Online Federal application for financial aid grants and loans.
- This application must be completed by the student seeking financial aid assistance and their parent or legal guardian
- The FAFSA will evaluate your eligibility (SAI/EFC numbers) once the application is completed.
- The application takes 3-5 days for processing and must be reviewed by a financial aid advisor.

NOTE: *Without a FAFSA Application, you will not have financial aid complete.*

NOTE: *Aid years need to match your application – EX: 25-26 Aid Year runs from AUG 2025 - JUN 2026*

WHAT DO YOU NEED FOR THE FAFSA APPLICATION?

You will need to fill in any blank information slots as you make your way through the application

➤ Your Date of Birth

➤ Your Social Security Number

➤ Your FULL Legal Name

➤ Tax Information

➤ Demographic Information

NOTE: You will need to create your own FSA ID Login

You will need your LEGAL GUARDIAN/PARENT on this form

➤ Without a parent or legal guardian, your FAFSA will be rejected making you ineligible for financial aid

➤ Your parent will need to receive the invite from YOU

➤ Your parent will need their own FSA login

BUT WHY??

WHAT DO THEY DO?

- ❑ After you have finished a 2026-27 FAFSA, you will need to contact your financial aid advisors.
- ❑ Each advisor can review your application 3-5 days after you and your parent/legal guardian have submitted your application.
 - ❑ This means they can see how much eligible Grant or Loan monies you may be able to use or what you have left
- ❑ Your advisor will build you a custom "FUNDING ESTIMATE" to review. (See above EXAMPLE)
- ❑ You can see the Max Offer first and make adjustments to fit your needs:
 - ❑ Reduce Loans
 - ❑ Add a Loan
 - ❑ Decide on a possible downpayment IF wanted
- ❑ Once you are satisfied with your offer, your advisor will help you sign and submit the F.E. and can assist you in completing some of the required e-forms if needed.
- ❑ We are here to support you in your financial aid process and be reached by booking through our Calendly Links or by email/call.



WHAT IS CAMPUS IVY? WHAT DO I DO HERE?

Campus IVY is a student site, kind of like Populi, where YOU fill in the blanks – E-forms, IDs, Proof of Grad, and more! All of these will be needed in order for you to be APPROVED for financial aid in addition to your FAFSA for the school year.

- NO – the FAFSA alone does not get your cleared
- YES – You need to e-sign forms and decide HOW you want your funds handled
- NO – This is not a bank
- YES – You can upload your docs as you go
- NO – You cannot complete the MPN and EC in Campus IVY
- YES – You can do this on your own OR you can have us help you!

VA STUDENT?

If you or your legal parent/guardian are a Veteran or are currently serving in the United States Military, you may be eligible for additional benefits:

- ❑ Check with the Veteran first - Ensure you can use the benefits!
- ❑ Speak with your advisor about the process. We will send you exact details about it.
- ❑ Apply for the benefits and obtain a **Certificate of Eligibility** through the VA Site
 - [VA SITE - Education Benefits](#)
- ❑ Obtain a copy of the **Veteran's DD 214**
- ❑ Turn in both documents to your advisor within 30 days of you starting classes!
 - EX: Spring Classes start on March 2, 2026 – you need to have docs in and cleared by a financial aid advisor **NO LATER THAN** March 31st, 2026
 - **Certification cannot be done late – You will not be cleared if you are past the 30 day cert period.**

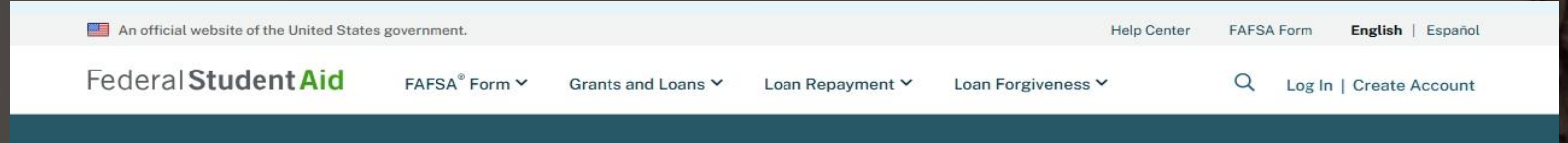


MPN? EC? What is that?

- Close all internet browser tabs other than the one you're using to complete the counseling.
- Do not to let your session time out while you're completing the counseling. Sessions time out after 15 minutes of inactivity.

Entrance counseling for undergraduate students is required if you have not previously received a Direct Subsidized Loan or a Direct Unsubsidized Loan.

You're an undergraduate student if you are enrolled in an undergraduate course of study that usually doesn't exceed four years and that leads to an undergraduate degree or certificate.

DO'S AND DON'TS OF FINANCIAL AID

Do NOT:

- Skip completing a FAFSA for the correct school year
- Forget our school code - 038744
- Ignore your financial aid advisor, especially if we call, text, and email
- Skip all your e-forms and required steps in Campus Ivy – You won't get Fin-Aid
- Forget to get all your VA Docs turned in to your advisor ASAP
- Forget to turn in all your required admissions docs
 - *High School Transcripts, State ID, and Enrollment Agreement*
- Get locked out of your sports activities because you didn't do your financial aid

DO:

- Complete the FAFSA with a parent/legal guardian
 - *Required for all students under 24 years old*
- Call or Book an appointment with your advisor
- Ensure all documents are turned in and completed NO LATER than a month into classes
- Check on the status of your financial aid by emailing your advisor
- Check your "FINANCIAL" tab in populi every term to ensure your financial aid is up to date
- Update your banking info (IF APPLICABLE)
